

Systematising of the Nepenthes screening regarding experiences/information on Indigenous Peoples, Gender and Natural Resource Management.

I. First Questionnaire (quantitative information)

12 questionnaires were sent out to Nepenthes contacts and organisations in Central America, among these 6 NGOs, 3 programmes/activities, 1 multilateral institution, and 2 researchers. Of these 5 answers were received of which 2 first questionnaires were filled out. Of these two, one is an indigenous NGO in Panama, one is a micro credit NGO in Honduras whose focus is not particularly on IP nor NRM, though some IP are among the receivers of credits. The other three answers were all giving additional information on the topics but did not qualify as NGOs to fill in the questionnaire.

The 5 answers were from the following countries:

Central America: Honduras, Panama

Afrika: Tanzania

The following Indigenous groups are covered:

Only 1 second questionnaire was sent out to the organisation in Panama who is working with both IP, NRM and gender/women's issues.

One questionnaire and request for information was sent out to the organiser of The Second Worldwide Symposium on Gender and Forestry to be held in Arusha, Tanzania in August 2004 by the Gender and Forestry Working Group of International Union of Forest. Also IP issues will be presented on the Symposium and information will be exchanged with IGNARM afterwards.

Considering the low number of questionnaires received it is not possible to elaborate any statistics on the material.
